What is “Summer Slide?”

“Summer slide” is the tendency for students, especially those with learning challenges or from low-income families, to lose some of the achievement gains they made during the previous school year.

Preventing Summer Slide will give you lots of suggestions and tips for teachers and parents to help their students avoid the summer brain drain and make reading and math practice easy and a lot of fun!

The “summer slide” often happens to struggling learners over the summer months. They often lose momentum, and even fall behind, over the summer months



Most students lose **TWO MONTHS** of grade equivalency in reading and mathematics every summer.



Summer learning loss is believed to account for 2/3 of the achievement gap in reading.
